FIRST:

SECOND:

CONSIDER THE OTHER PERSON OR SITUATION

WHAT REALLY MOTIVATED THEIR BEHAVIOR?

WHAT REALLY CAUSED THE SITUATION?

COULD IT BE ANCESTRAL?

THIRD:

CONSIDER WHY YOUR REACTED LIKE YOU DID

PAST TRAUMA AND HURTS?

FEARS

SELF PROTECTION - LACK OF TRUST
NEED FOR DELIVERANCE/HEALING
FEELING YOU ARE OWED SOMETHING

FOURTH:

CHOOSE TO ACCEPT WHAT HAPPENED AND TO LET IT GO - CHOOSE TO FORGIVE

THE SECOND WORD
