According to your Faith

Micah: see more physical healings. Asked God to speak to him about this. Lord, what do I need to do to have healing flow through me more? He said, you just need to believe more. (*"It is your faith when you pray, not what you have or have not done."*) He said you've got it, but you just don't fully believe it. Healing comes by faith...and so does deliverance.

When people don't get free, there's always a reason. When people don't get healed, there's always a reason. The big one main reason is the lack of faith...period. Faith is so powerful. Without faith, it is impossible to please God.

According to your faith, this means in a way that agrees with. That we do things in a way that agrees with God's word. That agrees with faith...that agrees God. And He says, you get in agreement with Me, and you begin to see eye to eye with Me, and all kinds of things will begin to happen.

Remember He said, first I will lead you by My hand. And then I'll grow you to where I'll lead you by My voice (the Pentecostal experience). But finally He said, and then I will lead you by My eye. When you behold Me and look into My eye, and we see eye to eye. And Jesus said, I only do what I see My Father do. There comes a place to where you begin to see what God's doing. Jesus said, if you believe, all things are possible.

It is significant, we found out that that's where it all starts in our life...in childhood. Everybody...that's where the enemy gets in...in childhood. It's always in childhood.

Something about faith that you've got to see it. The evidence of things not seen. You've got to see yourself heal. You've got to see yourself out of this. You've got to see yourself well and whole and free. That's the work of faith. The evidence of things not seen physically but seen spiritually. We believe and He does it.

Matthew 9:29 – *"According to your faith, let it be to you."* Why do I doubt? - So many reasons to stop the power of faith.

Mark 8:33 – *"He rebuked Peter, saying, "get behind me Satan, for you are not Mindful (setting mind on) of the things of God, but the things of men."* Not setting your mind on the things of God, but the things of men. What are we mindful of? What's on your mind? Your mindful of the wrong things.

Why is it so hard to believe? Micah made a list.

1. Believe for something, but it didn't happen
2. Remember failures of past
3. I am not worthy – I do not deserve to receive such
4. It is logically impossible
5. Others do not agree with such (Public Opinion)
6. What will others think of me? (Fear)
7. Fear of being embarrassed
8. It's too much to ask
9. It has never happened before
10. It don't understand how it works
11. Do not completely believe all that's in the bible.
12. Listen to my mind and not the Holy Spirit in my belly (gut)
13. It might be witchcraft
14. I am thinking of what to do if it doesn't work (double-mindedness)
15. What if it is not God's will?
16. Suffering and poverty are Godly – people believe this.
17. **Diagnosis and prognosis** – break the curse that's been spoken by anyone. Break the curse of the agreement – people agreeing against your healing. Written down in a file somewhere and it's like a curse written down about you about your future. When you go into a doctor and you sign things over, you given them authority over your body and what they say is very powerful because they've been given the authority to do so. Pray and renounce that and break the power in your life and say no. I will prosper and be in good health even as my soul prospers.

18. Powerful Symptoms – overshadow everything. Symptoms are symptoms. Symptoms we can deal with, but what caused the problem (like a headache, etc). We've got to get to the root. We've got to find the strongman. That's the key. He's the root.
19. Fear! What am I going to do? My symptoms? God's got a better way. Trust. Faith.

Romans 8:5-8 – *“For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. ⁶For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. ⁷Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. ⁸So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.”*

The battle in faith is in our mind. This is where the war starts, and this is where the war's got to be won. Set our minds on the things of the Spirit, which is God's word, God's promises, God's faithfulness, God's love for us, God's care for us, how important we are to God...instead of all these other things.

If I become spiritually minded, I receive life and peace comes from that as I dwell on the spiritual things...as I dwell on God's word...as I seek to be led of the Holy Spirit...as I seek to learn to hear His voice and be led of His Spirit, every moment of every day. That I let Him take over in my life and get out of this fear because the carnal mind is fearful. The carnal mind doubts. The carnal mind is an enemy of God. And yet, we listen to it and believe what it says. Lies, lies, lies.

James 4:7-8 – *“Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. (How do we resist him, we cast him out, keep him out.) Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.”*

Quit doubting. Quit doubting. Why do I do that? First of all, it's a choice, then God promised He'll work with us.

There's nothing that really can help somebody so much sometimes as when God touches their flesh and heals them. The big thing is to purify. Because this doubt is in the very core of our being. It's in our heart. It's been built in there for years. It's been programmed in there...to doubt, to question, to analyze, to critique...all this stuff that goes in our mind. The spirit-man doesn't do that. I've got a spirit-man in me that searches all my most inner parts. And what's he looking for? To drive things out that keep me from receiving all that He has for me

Purifying hearts by faith...believe – it cleanses me. It purifies me day by day by day. I make a choice. I want this Lord. I want a pure heart. What defiles it? Doubt! Just not really believing His word.

Three things to purify our hearts.

1. Faith (a person of faith – I trust God. I don't want anything or try to do anything without Him.)
2. With sincere love of the brethren (importance of local church – cleansing)
3. The hope that we shall be like Him for we shall see Him as He is.

That's why we're going through things. That's why we're tribulating. We're learning faith. We're learning to believe. We're learning to trust. We're learning to wait.

Prayer with Micah before Communion

Heavenly Father, we come before You because and in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Your Son. And we take this time Lord to look at ourselves.

Repeat: Father, in the name of Jesus of Nazareth, I come before You today and choose to let go of every doubt, every fear, every question and every bit of unforgiveness and bitterness. I renounce such to leave my life. Every unclean spirit of unforgiveness has caused bitterness, causes me to doubt, spirits of fear, leave me this day, in Jesus' name. I declare this day that I come that my heart be purified, that my hands be cleansed. And I will come purifying my heart by faith that You consider me such. By my love for the brethren and love not my life even unto death, I come before You this day, Lord, asking You to purify my heart of any questions, any doubts, in Jesus' name. Let everything be exposed that hinders me in my relationship with You and with my faith. I choose now this day to live by Your faith and not mine. So, thank You Lord that I can walk with You and see eye to eye with You, in Jesus' name.

Micah: Choose ye this day who you shall serve. The voices in your mind, the thoughts that come or the Holy Spirit. Choose you this day life or death. Blessings or cursings. It's up to you.

And so, in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, I bind every strongman in the sound of my voice. I bind you by the authority that's been invested in me through my Lord and Savior, and my Leader, Jesus. I rebuke you that you've got to let go of all your helpers. You're to be stripped of your armor and all your shields and all your thoughts and all your lies. You're to be exposed and to be driven out of our lives. We will not tolerate you. You must go, in Jesus' name. And so, we put you on notice...pack your little ditty bags and get ready to go. And all your helpers now that this house be plundered by the power of the blood of Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

Let the curses be broken. And let everything that wars in our minds be muffled and choked and stopped. That You Lord might manifest in our lives.
